Single crochet (sc)	Single crochet
Double crochet (dc)	Double crochet
Treble crochet (tr)	Triple crochet
Slip stitch (sl st)	Slip stitch
Chain (ch)	Chain

Crochet Pattern CP333: Step-by-Step Guide

Row 1

1. Make a magic ring.
2. 6 sc in the ring. (6)
3. Sl st to join.
4. Ch 1.

Row 2

1. 2 sc in each sc around. (12)
2. Sl st to join.
3. Ch 1.

Row 3

1. Sc in the first sc.
2. *2 sc in the next sc, sc in the next sc.* Repeat from * to * around. (18)
3. Sl st to join.
4. Ch 1.

Row 4

1. Sc in the first 2 sc.
2. *2 sc in the next sc, sc in the next 2 sc.* Repeat from * to * around.
(24)
3. Sl st to join.
4. Ch 1.

Row 5-12

1. Repeat Row 4 until the beanie reaches your desired length.

Row 13

1. Sc in the first 3 sc.
2. *2 sc tog, sc in the next 2 sc.* Repeat from * to * around. (18)
3. Sl st to join.
4. Ch 1.

Row 14

1. Sc in the first 2 sc.

2. *2 sc tog, sc in the next sc.* Repeat from * to * around. (12)
3. Sl st to join.
4. Ch 1.

Row 15

1. Sc in the first sc.
2. *2 sc tog, sc in the next sc.* Repeat from * to * around. (6)
3. Sl st to join.
4. Fasten off and weave in loose ends.

Tips and Customization

- Experiment with different colors and yarn weights to create unique beanies.
- Add a pom-pom to the top of the beanie for an extra touch of style.
- Adjust the length of the beanie by crocheting more or fewer rows.
- Use a ribbed stitch pattern for a more textured look.

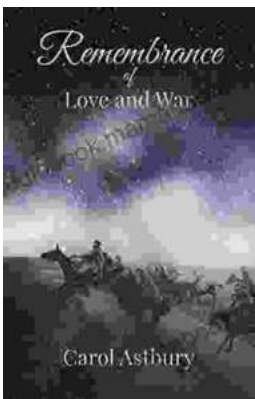

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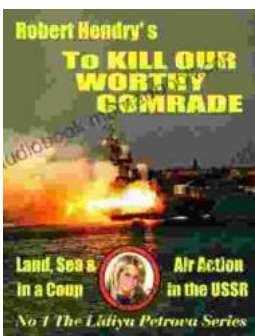


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
