1. Ask a spectator to choose a card from the deck. 2. Have them show you the card, then put it back in the deck. 3. Shuffle the deck thoroughly. 4.

Take the top card from the deck and put it in your pocket. 5. Ask the spectator to name their card. 6. Reach into your pocket and pull out the card. 7. It will be the spectator's card!

3. The Four Aces



This trick is a classic for a reason. It's simple, elegant, and always impressive. It's also a great way to practice your sleight of hand.

Materials:

* A deck of cards

Steps:

1. Spread the deck out face down on the table. 2. Ask a spectator to choose a card and remember it. 3. Have them put the card back in the deck, and shuffle it thoroughly. 4. Spread the deck out face down again. 5. Slowly turn over the cards one at a time, until you reach the spectator's card. 6. Turn the card over and show it to the spectator. 7. Repeat this process for the other three aces. 8. At the end, all four aces will be in a row.

4. The Rising Card



This trick is a bit more difficult than the others, but it's worth the effort. It's a great way to add some flair to your magic show.

Materials:

* A deck of cards

Steps:

1. Hold the deck in your left hand, with the cards facing down.
2. With your right hand, take the top card from the deck and place it on top of the deck.
3. Repeat this process, taking the top card from the deck and placing it on top, until you have about half of the deck in your right hand.
4. Hold the two halves of the deck together, with the cards in your right hand slightly higher than the cards in your left hand.
5. Slowly lower the cards in your right hand, as if you are letting them fall.
6. As the cards fall, the top card in your left hand will rise out of the deck.
7. You can repeat this process to make multiple cards rise out of the deck.

5. The Thought Card

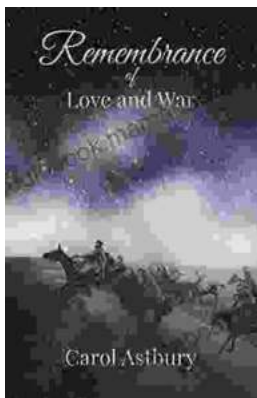
