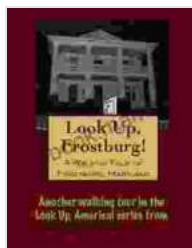


# Walking Tour of Frostburg, Maryland: Look Up America Series

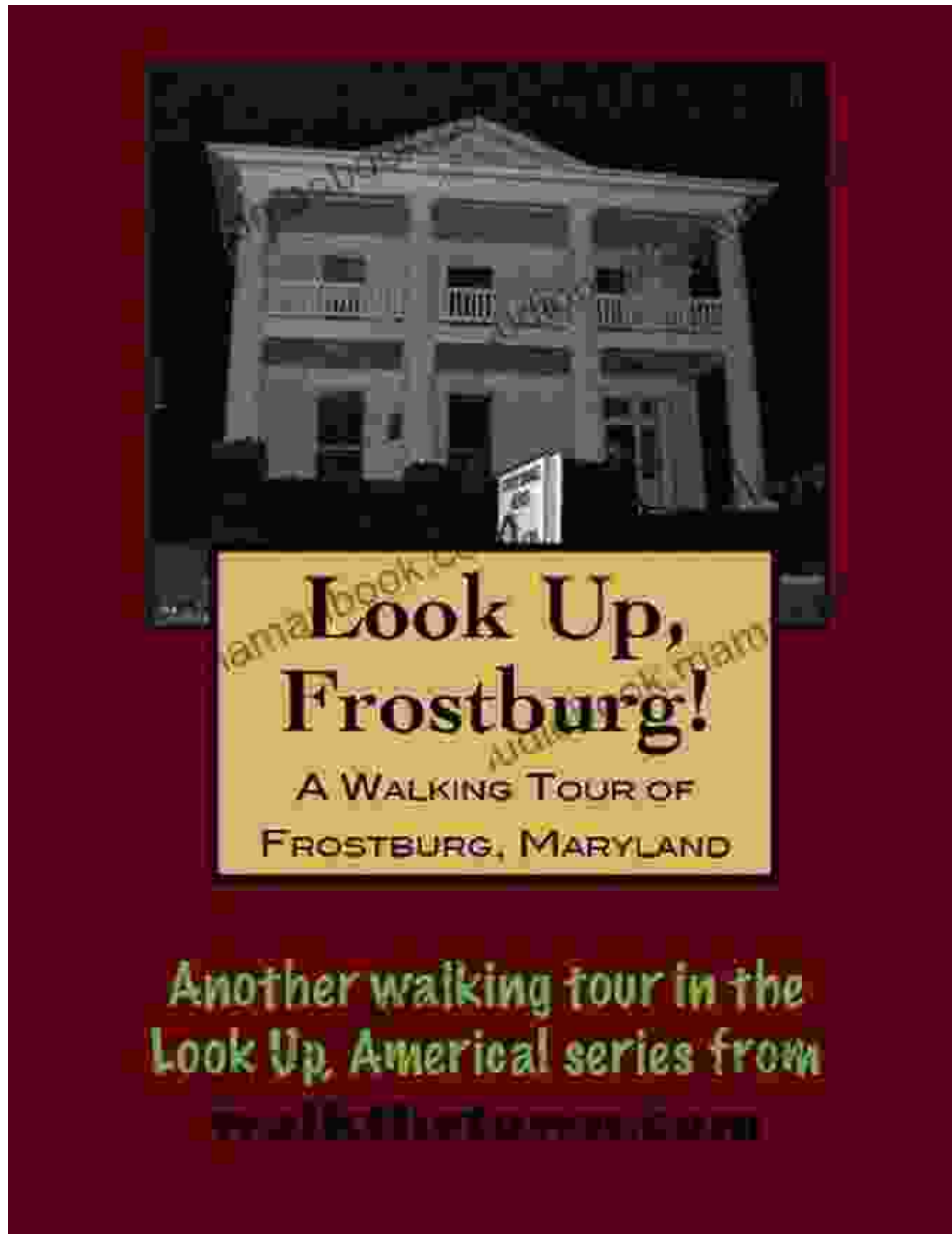

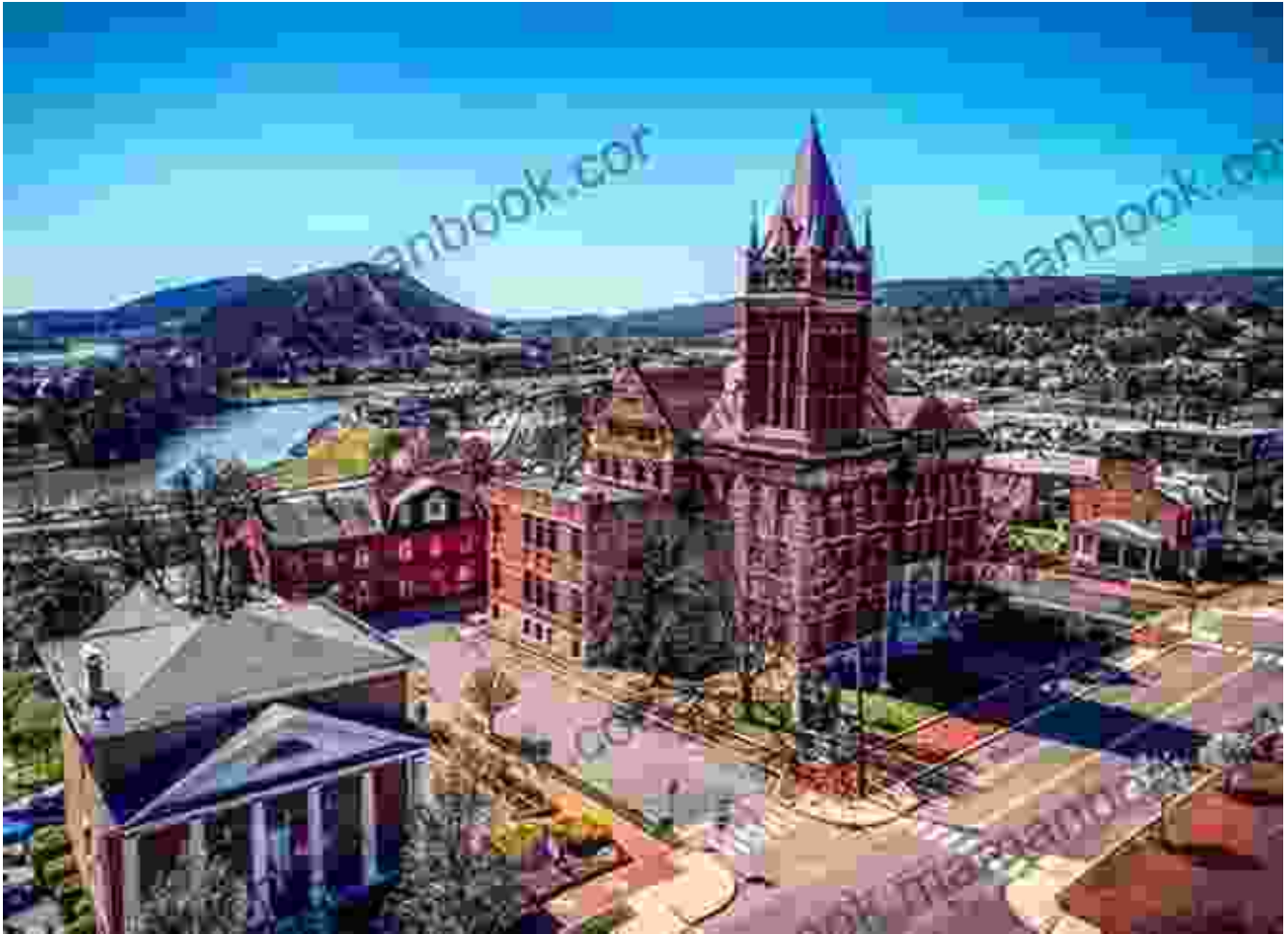


**Start: Frostburg Opera House**

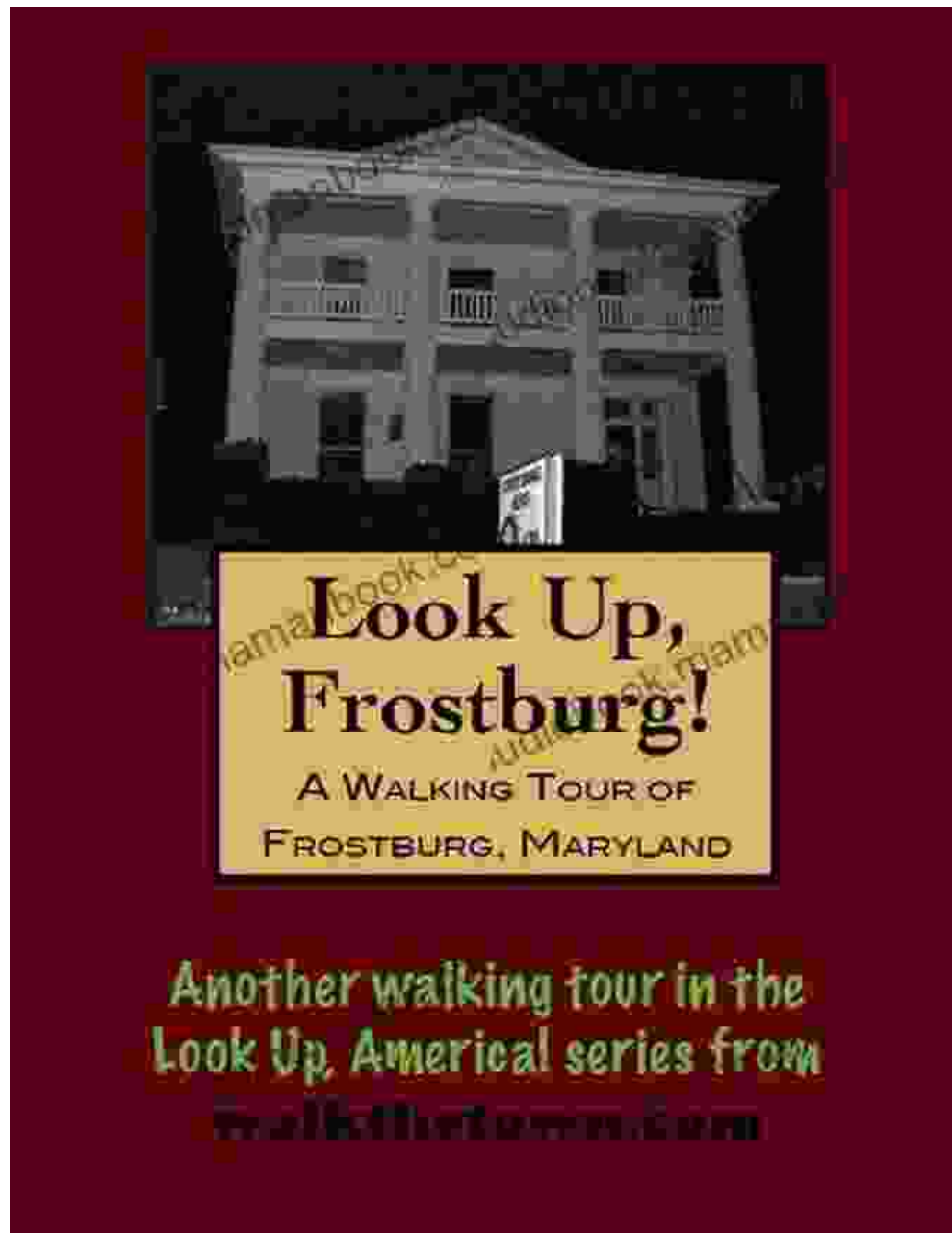

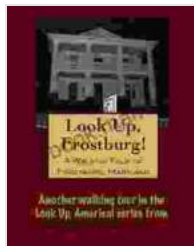

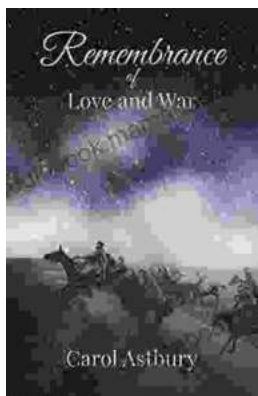
